AGENDA ITEMS

- *COVID-19, where to in 2021* **E Johnson / All**
 - Swimming 2021 – format?

COVID-19 sport requirements will remain as per Term 3 and 4 until restrictions are eased further. Delegates advised to plan as if restrictions will not be eased. All NSATIS and SSATIS delegates will meet on the 28th January to discuss any possible changes to requirements.

Discussion was had as to the requirements for a hired or shared venue. Mt Carmel have been asking teams to take own attendance of teams and spectators. When using an external venue, delegates should be guided by the requirements of the hirer.

The requirement of additional resources and personnel can be costly if ongoing, but schools need to ensure they are meeting requirements.

Swimming 2021 – Emma is liaising with the Aquatic Centre and Swimming Tasmania in regards to the SSATIS and SATIS carnivals in March.

- *Athletics debrief* **E Johnson / All**

The carnival was well received by all delegates and participants, with many schools liking the format of two sessions. The smaller teams and limited events meant the smaller schools were more competitive than in the traditional format.

It was noted that the weather was windy in the morning and most schools moved to the grandstand due to safety concerns with tents.

Discussion was had around the format of the program moving forward and all delegates agreed that they would like to still have the traditional program of events. It was raised having only one competitor per school per event eligible to score. With 14 schools competing in the carnival, having a second competitor in every event can put pressure on smaller schools and the length of the program, and by reducing to 1 competitor who scores per event, this would make teams more manageable for some schools and even the competition for smaller schools. Not all schools agreed to and this could not be a viable option if it detracted from participation.

Action: Athletics sub-committee meet to discuss and put proposal forward at the first meeting

- *Girls Year 7/8 Australian Rules Football review* **E Johnson**

Discussion was had regarding the inaugural Girls Year 7/8 Australian Rules roster.

John White spoke to the attached document from Friends’.

Overall schools were happy with the flexibility of team numbers, but it was agreed that communication should be had prior to the matches so teams can try and alleviate large benches. Teams should match players with the other team due to safety concerns if there is an unequal amount of players.

There was concern that moving the roster to Term 2 would see a drop in numbers due to club football being played.

Action: Review at the 2021 planning meeting (do we allow uneven numbers to play; and timing of the roster)

➤ *Soccer Grand Final festival*

Michael proposed that for 2021, SSATIS host a grand final festival for boys Year 7 – 10 soccer on the one night at Warrior Park. The 2020 Year 10 Soccer final was played at Warrior Park and it had great attendance and support.

This proposal was well received with the only concern being the change of night for the final to a regular roster. This can be well communicated at the beginning of the season and would only affect 2 teams per roster.

Action: Michael to work with Emma to have this up and running in 2021.

➤ *Boys cricket, requirements, regulations, scoring*

Emma called for a SSATIS Cricket sub-committee meeting to review the Boys and Girls SSATIS Cricket regulations.

Action: Michael, Jason, John, Mia and Emma to meet prior to first SSATIS Meeting in March.

➤ *Goal difference/goal percentage being in line with national bodies*

It was agreed that SSATIS should replicate what national sporting bodies do to determine ladder positions i.e goal percentage or goal difference.

Action: Emma to put together and distribute. Emma to discuss with Adrian to ensure database and website reflect the update.

➤ *Badminton state finals – need dates for the 2021 season for Year 11/12*

Delegates to notify Emma when the Badminton finals are to determine a SSATIS representative in the state final. Generally held in August / Term 2.

➤ *NSATIS minutes discussion*

➤ Rostering, NSATIS have proposed the below for 1st grade rosters

- In a 6 team roster – play 5 rounds, followed by semi-finals and a Grand Final.
- In a 5 team roster – play 4 rounds, followed by a qualifying final between 4th v 5th, then semi-finals: 1st v winner of qualifying final and 2nd v 3rd, concluding with a Grand Final between winners of semi-finals.
- In a 4 team roster – play 6 rounds (play each other twice), followed by a Grand Final.
- In a 3 team roster – play 4 rounds (play each other twice), followed by a Grand Final.

SSATIS agreed to apply this for 1st Grade Sports in 2021 for 6, 5 and 4 team rosters. If a roster only has 3 teams in the competition, discussion will be had by delegates and the SSATIS Admin Officer.

➤ Presentations at carnivals

Delegates agreed to the following process for presentations at Carnivals:

1. Acknowledge and present record breakers
2. Present winning school with pennants (no scores)
3. Present shields to winning schools noting scores for top three schools.

SSATIS agreed with this if instant results were available.

Action: Emma and Barb to speak with Adrian in terms of live updates for results

- *Meeting hosts 2021* – require a school for Friday 17th September, Athletics. St Virgil's
- *Delegate movement*
SCC – Kristy Nash has resigned from SCC, new delegate to be announced
CAL – Ken Holloway is leaving Calvin, Nathan Bosker 2021 Calvin SATIS delegate
SHC – Justin Mahoney is moving back to SVC, Adam Mills will return to SHC role in 2021
SACC – James Hickey stepping away from SATIS, Gemma Evans 2021 SACC SATIS delegate

Emma also announced that she will be expecting 3rd baby in June, 2021.

GENERAL BUSINESS

- *Boys Year 9/10 Cricket* – trophy, final
There is no present trophy, and stick to the status quo with no final.
- *Girls Cricket Blast* (Cricket Tas roster in Term 1) **Nikki Stuart**
Nikki spoke to the Cricket Tas cricket blast competition that has now been moved to Term 1 and which schools may be interested in. This would be a good competition to follow on from JSSATIS in Term 4 and lead into the SSATIS that is now run in Term 4. Schools showed interest in supporting this roster in Term 1. Nikki to take feedback to Cricket Tas.
- *2nd Grade teams competing in Year 10 rosters* – grand finals and trophies **Mel Brown**
Mel asked if we could revisit the regulation for 2nd Grade teams competing in Year 10 rosters so they can still play finals and be awarded trophies. It was agreed that this would be reviewed on a case by case basis, with the view that there will be more 2nd Grade teams entering the competition in future years.
- *SATIS Risk Management checklist* **Mel Brown**
The SATIS risk management checklist has not been updated for a number of years and not all delegates are using this tool.

Action: Emma and Barb to look at updating this document.
