BUSINESS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MEETING

- **Regulation 7.7**
Circulated via email

- **Division 1 teams playing in Division 2.** A reminder that at the previous meeting it was discussed that if schools are entering only one team in a competition that has two divisions and the delegate feels that the team is not of a Division 1 standard, they are to apply for a dispensation to be in Division 2. Application to be sent to Emma and then forwarded to Craig.

- **Swimming SSATIS 2020** **Emma**
Discussion of event. Pack documents distributed via email
- Time keepers (GYC 8 or 9 students, TFS the remainder)
 - Hot drink vouchers will be included in lunch packs
 - Staff are to bring own drink bottles and can be refilled from eskis in the meeting room
- **Head of the River 2020** **Emma**
Pack documents distributed via email, please ensure all rowing personnel have these. A reminder for delegates to ensure entries are correct.

- **Term 1 team nominations** **Emma**
 Review team nominations in Week 1 and starting rosters in Week 3.
 It was a rush and difficult to determine team numbers quickly at the beginning of the year as some schools had students on camp and started later in week 1 but all rosters got underway well.

 Emma and Michael (SVC) offered support to schools if wishing to set up electronic team registration. Schools could look to open registrations in December/January, which may assist in having a better idea of numbers prior to team nominations due.
- **Boys Year 9/10 Tennis** **Emma**
 Viable in Term 1 or move back to Term 4
 TFS are the only Year 9/10 only teams in 2nd Grade competition. The 2nd Grade teams can be intimidating to the 9/10 teams.

 Sporting schools now run development tennis in high schools. Justin to send through information to delegates

 Action: Boys Tennis in Term 1 will now be 2nd and 3rd Grade. No Year 9/10
- **Girls Year 7/8 Australian Rules – SSATIS rules and regulations** **Emma**
 Requirement for rules and regulations for Girls Year 7/8 Aussie Rules commencing in Term 4 2020.

 Girls youth rules for Under 15. Emma to put together, circulate and update the website.
- **Trophy Audit** **Emma**
 Commence after swimming
- **Rosters – division/year group** **Judith Davies**
 Judith asked why there is a mix of Year level and Grade level rather than just divisions (grades) and where do the students in Years 11/12 play if they aren't in 1st or 2nd Grade.

 Discussion was had that having year level is good for social reasons and students playing with peers. Divisions can suggest that it the rosters run best to least able but wouldn't restrict players playing in a particular year level. Changing to divisions is dependant on sport i.e tennis good for grades but footy not because of tackling and physical size difference in students.

 Action: All schools make a note of sports where they have an issue on having extra numbers that don't have a team or place to play and if there is a possibility of having divisional rosters rather than year level. Review at the planning meeting.
- **Referees and referee payments** **John White**
 TFS try and source paid referees but it has raised issues at school level as they aren't on payroll. DOM give visa gift cards as payment and GYC have a statement of supplier form they use.

 There are also discrepancies across the schools in how much referees are paid. Discussion on standardising payments for SSATIS Sport referees if organised with the referee directly by the host school. Some schools use associations to organise and allocate referees for an administration fee.

Action: Emma to set up google doc and all schools to enter the amount that referees are paid so schools can collaborate, with a view to standardising payments and having a central database of referees.

Emma to check the procedure and how SSATIS pay referees. Mel to send through statement of supplier form.

GENERAL BUSINESS

- Ken: Gaining interest of schools participating in Rugby, boys and girls. Delegates to enquire within their schools for interest, Ken to send information.
- Tennis minimum number of players
What constitutes a match? Minimum of 2 players and any missing players record a forfeit of 6-0 for that rubber. Delegates to inform other schools if having less than 4 players. Emma to update regulations.
- Year 7/8 and 9/10 boys footy ovals; availability and standard, NTHS and CHS?
Grounds are very limited and currently do not have enough grounds for teams entered. Schools who do not have grounds, are to try and source one so we can run the roster. Montrose bay ground is not available to use
