- **SSATIS Athletics 2020** **E Johnson**
- **Organising schools** – Emma has been in touch with organising schools and will liaise with delegates over the next two weeks
 - **School duties** – School officials spreadsheet is being updated and will send to schools as soon as possible
 - **Team packs** – information will go out as soon as available
 - **Entries** – Brian Roe will distribute entry forms based on indication of teams being entered, number of teams to be to Brian **5:00pm Monday 24 August, 2020.**
 - **Points** – points will be awarded as proposed and contribute as per SSATIS regulations to pennant flags and shields. Pennant flags and shields will be awarded post carnival if unable to do on the day.
 - **Records** – it was agreed that records for all age groups in the events available will be awarded. Brian Roe suggested that a younger age athlete competing against an older age athlete i.e Under 13 with Under 14, does not provide a significant advantage for the younger athlete. Any records broken will be announced post the carnival once the results are finalised.

Mel Brown from GYC noted that for her school the nitro style event for the SSATIS 2020 carnival has disadvantaged her students. With the reduction of events, students are missing out due to event not being available and it was unclear how limiting the number of events but allowing two teams per pennant was practical.

Other schools commented that the setup for 2020 has been welcomed because with the reduced number of events and students required, it has meant their school can field an athletics team. Emma noted that Brian Roe from Athletics Tas, who has expertise with running Athletics Carnivals, has used his knowledge to provide a program that provides an opportunity for schools to have a carnival in 2020.

- **SSATIS/NSATIS Rosters alignment** **All**
- Proposed document for 2021 was sent to delegates and proactive discussion was had in aligning the SSATIS sports with NSATIS sports. Ideally it would be great to have all 7 – 10 and 1st/2nd Grade sports align but with gym and ground availability this was not feasible. As a result there have been significant changes to the SSATIS sport calendar for 2021 and all 1st/2nd Grade rostered sports are aligned with NSATIS
